This page describes our Cookies Policy for <https://www.ltco.lu> (the "website") operated by the ATOZ Group.

For almost any modern website to work properly, it needs to collect certain basic information on its users. To do so, the website will create files known as cookies on its users' computers.

## WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer or mobile phone when you browse websites. Cookies are designed to allow the website to recognise you, or to authorise other designated websites to recognise you for a particular purpose. Cookies can be used to collect, store and share bits of information about your activities across websites, including on ATOZ Group websites.

Our Cookies might be used for the following purposes:

- Allow our website to work as you would expect
- Make your experience of the Internet much smoother and more interactive.
- Remember your preferences on the sites you visit
- Improve the speed/security of the site
- Allow you to share pages to social networks (Facebook, Twitter, Google+ and LinkedIn)
- Continuously improve our website for you
- Help you navigate between pages more efficiently

We do not use cookies to:

- Collect any personally identifiable information
- Collect any sensitive information
- Pass data onto advertising networks
- Pass personally identifiable data onto third parties
- Pay sales commissions

r/collect (IDE)	Google Analytics	Tracking for statistics (Used to send data to Google Analytics via DoubleClick's integrated solutions for digital marketing proposes.)	Session

## WHAT ABOUT COOKIES AND GDPR COMPLIANCE?

As our website visitors are not authenticated (logged in), we do not collect any personally identifiable information or sensitive information.

For business use:

- We request your active consent to add your email to our direct marketing mailing lists
- We collect data you provide/submit through a webform as necessary for our legitimate interests

For Administrators and Editors, who, unlike users, are authenticated, we store session information to allow them to be kept logged in.

Our Third-Party providers are compliant with the European General Data Protection Regulation (The « GDPR »). See the privacy policy links below for each Third-Party.

## WHAT TYPES OF COOKIE DO WE USE?

ATOZ Group uses two types of cookie:

- **Session cookies** are temporary. They allow website operators to follow the actions of a user during a browser session. A browser session starts when a user opens the browser window and ends when the user closes the browser window. Once you close the browser, all session cookies are deleted.
- **Persistent cookies** remain on a user's device for a set period of time specified in the cookie. They are activated each time that the user visits the website that created that particular cookie.

## HOW DO THIRD PARTIES USE COOKIES ON THE LTCO WEBSITE?

Third party companies like analytics companies generally use cookies to collect user information on an anonymous basis. They may use that information to build a profile of your activities on the website.

### Visitor Statistics Cookies

We use cookies to compile visitor statistics such as statistics on how many people have visited our website, what type of technology they are using (e.g. Mac/Windows, Mobile/Tablet/Laptop which helps to identify when our site isn't working as it should for particular technologies), how long they spend on the site, what pages they visit etc. This helps us to continuously improve our website and browsing experience. These so called "analytics" programs also tell us if and how people reached the website (e.g. from a search engine).
